Healing Scripture

Psalm 103:2-5

10-Year-Old Boy HEALED!

Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of Heaven belongs to such as these (NIV)."

It's not often that children come to our healing services. When they do come they are almost always the same: shy, quiet, and they easily find that special nook in mom or dad's arms to hide, but not 10-year-old William. He had no nook to find comfort in. With his mother unable to come, he came as the guest of one of our lay ministers, Barry.

When I first locked eyes with this young child, I could see pain in his eyes—fear and longing. I had the opportunity to pray a blessing over him, and God showed me His plan is to give William clarity and understanding of the Word, and he will teach it to others. I told William this, which I pray he remembers and is encouraged by in years to come. (I found out early the next week he is teaching his neighbor how to read. God is already molding him into a teacher!)

At this point, he began to open up. He explained he fell out of a tree a year earlier, hurt his ribs, and still had pain in his side. He kept repeating it over and over, almost hopelessly. I remember thinking, *How can a child appear so hopeless? Aren't we commanded to become like little children because of the 'child-like' faith they possess?* It seemed to me William had become like an adult, with the heavy weight of doubt on his shoulders caused by one disappointment after another.

We prayed for the pain in his side, believing God would heal him. God loves children, and He loves to meet their

needs. (Aren't *we* his children? Doesn't he love to meet *our* needs?)

That night at 11pm, his mother called Barry to thank him for praying for William. She explained the pain left his side, and he is so excited he can't wait to return—and God can't wait to come to the next healing service either!

When I go to the healing service, I always expect God to do great things. God reveals his glory and goodness without fail. He reminds all in attendance of His great love for us and His

desire to impact our lives in "supernatural" ways, which are simply natural to Him. These qualities are a part of His divine nature. As it says in 2 Timothy, "...he cannot deny who He is (NLT)." I like the commentary Wesley's Notes provide on this scripture: "If we believe not—That is, though some believe not, God will make good all His promises to them that do believe. He cannot deny himself—His word cannot fail." Amen. Chrissy Rummel
