The Teach Ministry Director is responsible for planning, implementing and overseeing the Discipling/Christian Education program of the church.

ANTICIPATED TIME COMMITMENTS

1. **Doing ministry/preparing for ministry:** four hours each week
2. **Participating in meetings/training:** one hour minimum a month

RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES

1. Plan and implement the Discipleship/Christian education program of the church to raise the maturity level of church members.
2. Meet quarterly with Teach Ministry Area Team Captains to review, evaluate, and vision for teaching ministries.
3. Review, approve, and establish curricula.
4. Attend and promote appropriate continuing education events.

5. Offer Class 201, Discovering Spiritual Maturity, 3 times per year.
6. Work to keep other ministry area leaders informed about the educational needs of persons, the goals of the Teach Ministry Area, and the resources available that will help reach those goals.
7. Plan and conduct meetings, seminars and activities to recruit and train teachers.
8. Be familiar with the overall goals the congregation has set, how these goals influence the Teach Ministry Area programs, and how these goals may be extended.
