

BEING IN THE KINGDOM OF GOD

Matthew 6:33

"Seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added unto you." - Jesus

- A kingdom has a king. In the Kingdom of God, Jesus is the king.
- What does it mean that Jesus is king? It means that if I am in His Kingdom:
 1. He is my king
 2. He is my teacher
 3. His plans are my plans
 4. His purposes for me are His purposes.
 5. When He calls, "I say yes," not, "Let me think about it."
- In a kingdom, the king makes the rules, not the people.
- In the Kingdom of God, every promise the king ever made is kept.
- In the LORD's prayer when it says, "Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven," Jesus is proclaiming a kingdom.
- Where is the Kingdom of God on earth? Earthly kingdoms (or nations) have territory.

The Kingdom of God is faithful believers of the king of the kingdom. It is people.
- If you are a faithful follower (or better, disciple) of Jesus, then you are not only in the kingdom, you are part of the kingdom.

- Where the faithful are, there is the kingdom. If you at work, there is the kingdom - where you are at work.
- We were made to be with others in the kingdom.
- The Holy Spirit in believers is the Spirit of Jesus the king. Where the Holy Spirit is there is the kingdom.
- When 1 Corinthians 15:24 says: ***"Then the end will come, when he (Jesus) hands over the Kingdom to God the Father after He has destroyed all dominion, authority, and power."*** Jesus is talking about handing over to the Father those in His Kingdom to be in Heaven with Him.
- The Kingdom of God changes people around us (through the Holy Spirit in us.)
- The Kingdom of God has the SEEN and the UNSEEN. People are the SEEN, the Holy Spirit and the angels of God are the UNSEEN.
- As a member of the Kingdom of God, we are a blessing disperser through the Holy Spirit.
- Humans are designed to live from the inside out.
- Remember, Jesus is the king if we are in His kingdom. I am not the king! I am no longer the king of my life. He is.
