**S—time for spiritual connection.**

*“Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed.”*  
—Mark 1:35

**T—time to de-compress time.**

*For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day.*  
—Exodus 20:11
