3 Memorial Feasts

- Unleavened bread or Passover, Exodus 12:13, Leviticus 23:4-8
- Weeks or Pentecost, 50 days after Passover, Leviticus 23:15-21
- Booths or Ingathering, Leviticus 23:33-34

A. Redemption

B. Covenant, Exodus 2:24, 19:4-6

C. Law—10 Commandments, Exodus 20:1-17

D. Worship—Tabernacle, Sacrifices, Priests, Exodus 24ff.

3. Foreshadowing the Lamb of God—Jesus Christ
