

Worship is... Exalting Almighty God

- What you worship is what you spend most of your time on.
- All of the songs in Heaven are praises. No sad songs.
- Worship creates an atmosphere that Almighty God can enjoy. God would like a nice time too. Worship is exalting Him !
- Worship is never something to receive. Worship is scripturally something to give to God.
- When I (my "I") disappear, God shows up.
- Worship is designed by God for how He wants us to worship Him on any particular occasion. It is not about my clock (or my schedule).
- Worship is primary, intense, joyful. God is 1st. The only focus.
- During my worship I am to take the focus off of myself and those around me. Then ask God, "How do You want me sing, pray, listen, praise?"
- I want to get lost in worship. ONLY Jesus.
- Anointings are particularly powerful during and after worship. Why? Because the Holy Spirit is already there.
- Don't let the devil steal your joy.
- The Book of Psalms is the **WORSHIP BOOK OF THE BIBLE**. It shows us how Almighty God wants to be worshiped.
- Read the Psalms every morning. Pay attention to how it says to worship. What God said then, still applies today. "He is same yesterday, today, and tomorrow."
- The book of Psalms (in the middle of the Bible) shows us "keys" to unlock the doors that bring God into the Sanctuary. Learn these keys.
- Worship is about exalting Almighty God.
