

Going From Head Faith To Heart Faith

(God speaking) ***"I will put My laws in their minds, and I will write them on their hearts."*** —Hebrews 8:10

There is head knowledge, and there is heart knowledge. This is with all areas of faith things.

Head knowledge is knowing something about something.

Heart knowledge happens when God sees us investing time to know and understand something special about our relationship with Him and He takes that knowledge, deepens it by placing a part of Himself with it, and places it into our hearts. Then we are empowered with it.

John Wesley going from head knowledge of faith to heart knowledge of faith.

Proverbs 4:21-23 (part of those words of wisdom says) ***"Out of the heart come issues of life."***

For the believer some of those issues of Life (capital "L" life) are: AGAPE, healing, worshiping, personal relationship with Jesus Christ, the cross, Holy Communion

Psalm 42:7 ***Deep calls to deep.*** (meaning, the Holy Spirit speaks His deeper meanings to those who understand with their heart, not just with their head in what He wants to reveal to us.)
